### **Academic Semesters and Sessions, Definitions of**

### **Purpose**

To describe the length of an academic semester (Fall and Spring) and session (Summer).

# **Policy**

The academic year is divided into two semesters of approximately 15 weeks each (14 weeks of instruction plus 1 week of final exams). Summer sessions, when available, are generally provided eightweek sessions (with final exams occurring on the last day of the eight-week session).

## **Scope and Definitions**

This policy applies campus-wide.

#### **Procedure**

The Vice-President for Academics establishes the academic sessions five years ahead of their start.

Instructors will have one week of academic preparation time per regular semester and at least three days of academic preparation time for a eight-week summer session.
