This application is for on-campus residential housing at Haskell.

ALL admitted students can apply for a housing assignment. It is highly recommended that applicants first register for courses.

In order to receive a housing assignment:

- a) If you attended Haskell in a previous semester, you must have a 2.0 cumulative GPA;
- b) If you are a new, entering student, you must be admitted to Haskell before you apply for housing;
- c) You must be enrolled as a full-time student (taking 12 hours of courses for the next semester);
- d) If you attended Haskell in a previous semester, you must be in good social standing, which means that you have not lost housing privileges because of Code of Conduct violations. 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| Residential Life Housing Contract & Guidelines – please review and initial after each statement: |
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1. Upon occupying or vacating an assigned room, every student must update their residential packet of documents with the Residential Services staff. Claiming a space, which is defined as accepting a key or placing belongings in the room, constitutes binding acceptance of this contract, and the student shall be responsible for the full amount of charges for the aforementioned contractual period. _____
2. Only a student enrolled full-time (12+ hours) may occupy a room in university housing. An assigned room should be used for personal residence only. _____
3. The University reserves the right to enter rooms as outlined in the Student Code of Conduct. Care will be exercised to ensure each student's right to privacy while living in student housing units. _____
4. A student may be required to move to either accommodate another student, due to repairs, disciplinary issues, or other unpredictable situations. _____
5. Residents may make a request to the Director of Residential Services to exchange room assignments with another student if both students and all affected roommates agree to the change. The Director of Residential Life reserves the right to approve or reject such requests on a case-by-case basis. _____
6. Residents must be aware of and follow the policies, procedures, and regulations pertaining to living in housing units as outlined by the Residential Life Student Handbook, the Code of Student Conduct, and all local, state, and federal laws. Failure to comply with laws or university Residential Life policies may result in the immediate cancellation of this housing contract. _____
7. Residents are held financially responsible for all damages they cause in public or private areas of the student housing units. _____
8. Residents are encouraged to obtain protection (renter's insurance) from loss or damage to property and/or for personal liability. Haskell is not responsible for any damaged, lost, or stolen property. _____
9. If a housing contract is cancelled because the student violated policies or laws, the student cannot reapply for housing for one calendar year from the date of that cancellation. _____
10. Failure to vacate an assigned room and remove contents may result in charges assessed of \$50 per day for up to five days, after five days items will be removed and stored at the resident's expense. _____
11. NO pets are allowed. Service or emotional support animals may be allowed as a necessary accommodation for students with documented disabilities by pre-arrangement and approval of the Disability Coordinator. For more information, e-mail ADAServices@haskell.edu. _____
12. The room is strictly for personal use and no business should be conducted in the space assigned to include babysitting, food sales, etc. _____
13. Microwaves, electric skillets, hot plates, and other cooking equipment are not permitted in the residence halls. _____
14. It is the responsibility of the student to notify the College Resident Assistant in writing within twenty-four hours (24) after taking occupancy, should they disagree with the conditions of their room and/or contents. Failure by the student to notify the CRA of any discrepancy shall indicate approval and acceptance. _____
15. I have read and understand the Haskell Residential Services contract and agree to abide by the conditions outlined. _____
16. I agree to abide by all policies set forth in the Haskell Residential Life Student Handbook and Code of Student Conduct and Responsibilities. _____
